

### Description

The ACE4054D is a complete constant-current/ constant-voltage linear charger for single cell lithium rechargeable battery. No external sense resistor is needed, and no blocking diode is required due to the internal P-MOSFET architecture. Furthermore, the ACE4054D is specifically designed to work within USB power specifications. Its low external component count makes the ACE4054D ideally suited for portable applications. Thermal feedback regulates the charge current to limit the die temperature during high power operation or high ambient temperature. The charge current can be programmed externally with a single resistor. The ACE4054D automatically terminates the charge cycle when the charge current drops to 3/10th the programmed value after the final float voltage is reached. When the input supply (wall adapter or USB supply) is removed, the ACE4054D automatically enters a low power sleep mode, dropping the battery drain current to less than  $2\mu$ A. The ACE4054D can be put into shutdown mode, reducing the supply current to  $50\mu$ A. Other features include battery pack temperature monitor, undervoltage lockout, automatic recharge and two status pins to indicate charging and charge termination.

- 2. All voltages are with respect to network ground terminal.
- 3. The ACE4054D are guaranteed to meet performance specifications from 0°C to 70°C. Specifications over the –40°C to 85°C operating temperature range are assured by design, characterization, and correlation with statistical process controls.
- 4. The human body model is a 100pF capacitor discharged through a 1.5kΩ resistor into each pin. The machine model is a 200pF capacitor discharged directly into each pin.


5. If VCC is between UVLO and 4.5V, and above the battery voltage, then the IC is active (can deliver some charge to the battery), but the IC will have limited or degraded performance (some functions may not meet data sheet specifications). The battery may be undercharged (V<sub>FLOAT</sub> less than in the specification), but will not be overcharged (V<sub>FLOAT</sub> will not exceed specification).

6. The thermal regulation feature reduces charge current if the IC's junction temperature reaches 125°C; thus, without a good thermal design the maximum programmed charge current may not be reached.

7. Use a 1% tolerance metal film resistor for RPROG to avoid issues with the RPROG short test when using the maximum charge current setting.
